**\*Sunday Worship. Join us this "Christ the King" Sunday at 8:30 a.m. (Classical) or 10:00 a.m. (Contemporary) As always, all Worship services gather in-person, via livestream, and are recorded.** For those joining us for the livestream, you can go to our website [www.redhillchurch.org](http://www.redhillchurch.org) and scroll down to *Worship Livestream*. **\*Current Message Series: "I Love My Church!"** Scripture reveals, and the Lutheran Confessions affirm, that in His love, God is on a mission to *redeem* and *reconcile* the world through Jesus Christ. In order to carry out this divine mission, Jesus has commanded His church to *make* and *send* disciples. A disciple is one called through the Gospel to be a *student*, an *apprentice* of Jesus. God has promised that He will feed and equip His disciples through Word and Sacrament, in the power of the Holy Spirit, for faithful living. The *purpose*, *vision*, *mission*, and *core values* of Red Hill Lutheran Church and School, describe the *culture* and *climate* we seek to create for the purpose of equipping and sending disciples of Jesus Christ into the world. This Sunday, as we come to the end of our short series on the mission and ministry of the church, we explore the natural result of growing in faith and love—*servicing God and others!*

**\*\*Wednesdays in the Word:\*\* The Gospel of Mark.** The Gospel of Mark is a historical-biography of the life of Jesus Christ. Likely the first Gospel written, Mark details Jesus' ministry from Jesus' Baptism to Easter, revealing how Jesus came to bring in the Kingdom of God. Additionally, Mark tells the story of how the disciples' came to understand who Jesus *truly was* (as opposed to their assumptions about Jesus' person and purpose), and how He came to heal this hurting world. Join us, for this in-depth study in God's Word! This study is from **7:00 a.m. to 7:45 a.m. in the Church Sanctuary (This class meets in person, via livestream, and is recorded)**.
