***New Sermon Series: "I Love My Church!"** This Sunday, we begin a new message series examining the nature, purpose, and mission of the church generally, and Red Hill Lutheran specifically! Red Hill Lutheran Church and School exists, as do all churches, through the promises and power of the *Triune God*. In the Gospel of Matthew, Jesus gives to the church its commission and His promises:

"Then Jesus came to them and said, 'All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. ¹⁹ Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. ***"Wednesdays in the Word." The Gospel of Mark.** Every Wednesday morning, we gather for a verse-by-verse study in God's Word. The Gospel of Mark details Jesus' ministry from Jesus' Baptism to Easter, revealing how Jesus came to bring in the Kingdom of God. Additionally, Mark tells the story of how the disciples' came to understand who Jesus *truly was* (as opposed to their assumptions about Jesus' person and purpose), and how He came to heal this hurting world. This study begins at **7:00 a.m. to 7:45 a.m. in the Church Sanctuary (This class meets in person, via livestream, and is recorded)**.
