*John 16.32 Behold, the hour is coming, indeed it has come, when you will be scattered, each to his own home, and will leave me alone. Yet I am not alone, for the Father is with me.*

*Psalm 118.6-7 The LORD is on my side; I will not fear. What can man do to me? <sup>7</sup>The LORD is on my side as my helper; I shall look in triumph on those who hate me.*

*John 16.20-22 Truly, truly, I say to you, you will weep and lament, but the world will rejoice. You will be sorrowful, but your sorrow will turn into joy. <sup>21</sup>When a woman is giving birth, she has **sorrow** because her hour has come, but when she has delivered the baby, she no longer remembers the **anguish**, for joy that a human being has been born into the world. <sup>22</sup>So also you have sorrow now, but I will see you again, and your hearts will rejoice, and no one will take your joy from you.*

*Psalm 118.13 I was pushed hard, so that I was falling, but the LORD helped me.*
