Matthew 15.21-24 And Jesus went away from there and withdrew to the district of Tyre and Sidon. ²² And behold, a Canaanite woman from that region came out and was crying, “Have mercy on me, O Lord, Son of David; my daughter is severely oppressed by a demon.” ²³ But he did not answer her a word. And his disciples came and begged him, saying, “Send her away, for she is crying out after us.” ²⁴ He answered, “I was sent only to the lost sheep of the house of Israel.”

*Matthew 15.25-27 But she came and knelt before him, saying, “Lord, help me.” ²⁶ And he answered, “It is not right to take the children's **bread** and throw it to the **dogs**.” ²⁷ She said, “Yes, Lord, yet even the dogs eat the **crumbs** that fall from their masters' table.”*

ἄρτον (*arton*): “Loaf” “Bread” κυναρίους (*kunarios*): “Little dog” ψιχίων (*psichion*): “Morsel”

The Gospel: “We are more broken and sinful than we would ever dare admit; but at the same time more loved and accepted than we could ever dare hope.”
