***Current Sermon Series: "Renewed."** Saint Paul, writing to the church in Colossae, reminds the followers of Jesus: "*Set your minds on things that are above, not on things that are on earth.* ³ *For you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God...* ¹⁰ *...put on the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge after the image of its creator....* (Colossians 3.2-3, 10) As disciples of Jesus, we have been given a *new life*, we have, and are, being *renewed* after the image of our creator! As I have said many times, all of us are "under construction," as God *renews His image* in us which has been marred by sin. This Sunday, we explore what the Bible tells us about being renewed in our spirit!
