Pastor Peter's Perspective



^{«35} Then Philip opened his mouth, and beginning with this Scripture he told him the good news about Jesus. ³⁶ And as they were going along the road they came to some water, and the eunuch said, "See, here is water! What prevents me from being baptized?" ³⁷ And Philip said, "If you believe with all your heart, you may." And he replied, "I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God." ³⁸ And he commanded the chariot to stop, and they both went down into the water, Philip and the eunuch, and he baptized him." -Acts 8:35-38

August is baptism month for my boys; Lucas was baptized on Aug. 6 and Grant on Aug. 11. I so vividly remember the moment when they were each baptized in our church. We celebrated alongside our family, friends, the boys' Godparents, and our congregation. They were such special and holy moments for Lucas and Grant... as God welcomed them into His BIG family, forgave their sins, and claimed them as His children. We still celebrate and remember their baptisms all these years later...

Because baptism changes everything.

Read through Acts 8:26-40 (a portion of it is above) and you'll discover an Ethiopian eunuch who worked for the queen. He had come to Jerusalem to worship and was returning home in his chariot. On the ride home, he was reading through Isaiah's prophecies and didn't quite understand what he was reading. So the Spirit sent Philip, a new disciple, to help the Ethiopian understand the Scripture.

"Philip asked, "Do you understand what you are reading?" The man replied, "How can I, unless someone guides me?"" Acts 8:30b-31a. With the help of the Holy Spirit, Philip helped the Ethiopian understand the text... and the Spirit led the man to be baptized right then and there! Talk about a fast Baptism class! But doesn't this story get to the heart of the Gospel? Philip led the man to Jesus using Old Testament prophecies. And the man responded with, "See, here is water! What prevents me from being baptized?" Nothing. Nothing at all. And so Philip baptized this man and God claimed him as His own. He left rejoicing and changed!

Baptism changes everything.

The Gospel of Jesus is for all people, no matter who they are, where they work, who their boss is (whether a queen or not), and no matter what they've done. God sent Jesus to the world out of love for the world. Let's be like Philip and help others understand this Good News and prayerfully lead people to be baptized. We have water and we have God's Word! Let's keep baptizing! And let's keep remembering the promises God made in our own baptisms – that we are forgiven and forever His!

And Faith has two more brothers being baptized this month! We will celebrate with Joe and Luke as they receive God's grace in baptism on Aug. 4! God is good!

And all God's baptized children said, Amen!
