### FINANCE MANAGER JOB DESCRIPTION

#### Overview

The Finance Manager has the responsibility to ensure the church's financial operations are processed and reported with accuracy and integrity. The position requires forward-thinking and a propensity to handle shifting technologies well. Responsibilities include the oversight and management of all financial areas of the church, including accounting, budgeting, forecasting, analysis, reporting, financial services, contract management and compliance.

# **Essential Duties and Responsibilities**

- Maintains appropriate and accurate church financial records, including the recording of receipts and online giving, reconciliation of weekly bank deposits, processing and administration of vendor payments, and monthly reconciliation of all accounts. Ensures existence of audit trail for all transactions.
- Works in collaboration with the Faith Leadership Board Treasurer and Finance Committee, communicates regularly about the financial health of the congregation, provides monthly financial and budget performance statements, and responds in a timely fashion to financial inquiries from the Leadership Board, committees, staff, and church members.
- Performs financial planning analysis and forecasts to provide valuable insight for optimal
  decision making used to further Faith's Strategic Plan of "Connect, Grow & Serve" including
  staying abreast of current trends impacting stewardship, attendance and finances. Prepares
  the annual budget for the church and Faith Child Care and Nursery School (FCCNS) in
  collaboration with all persons with budget line-item responsibility, both Finance Committees,
  and the Leadership and FCCNS Boards.
- Assists with the stewardship process for both annual giving and long-term funds development. Keeps accurate records of all restricted gifts and reserve balances.
- Communicates with donors including preparation of tri-annual giving statements and acknowledgment of memorial and special gifts.
- Administers Faith's human resource needs, including the preparation of payroll, appropriate
  maintenance of employee files and paid time off, execution of necessary background checks
  and documentation related to hiring and termination, management of all employee benefit
  plans, and processing of year-end 1099s and W-2s.
- Provides logistical support to Faith's Property Team as it relates to facility operations, including the maintenance of church insurance records.

- The Finance Manager reports to the senior member of the pastoral staff and Leadership Board.
