### Pastor Peter's Perspective

"Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age," Matthew 28:19-20.



Christ calls us to "Go and make disciples!" It's a simple, yet profound directive from Jesus! "Go" is the catalyst for our lives and our life together as God's people.

#### "Go" with Jesus

Christ promises to be "with you always, to the very end of the age." You're not going alone into your neighborhood, school, workplace, and community... you're going with Jesus and His Church! Christ has been with you since your baptism and He walks with you wherever you go. How comforting and encouraging is that?!

#### "Go" is for all of us

This active command is not just for your pastor or a select few... it's for every Christ follower! Each of us has been gifted by God with spheres of influence where we can make disciples of Jesus, with the help of the Holy Spirit.

I created the artwork above for the Celebration of Ministry service on Jan. 14. "Go" is the theme of that worship service, just as it's been my personal theme and goal throughout my ministry in God's Kingdom. The artwork features a map of Rochester & Penfield inserted into the word, "Go." Our church is located in the center of the "O" to remind us that we are to "Go" into all the world, starting in our church, then out to our neighborhoods, communities, and world. The green color symbolizes life and growth as God's Kingdom expands in Rochester and around the world.

May the Spirit of the living God propel us forward as we embrace the command to "Go and make disciples," trusting in the promise that Jesus is with us always! Let's GO!

### Stewardship Message from the Faith Leadership Board

We give thanks for the blessed support that our congregation continues to provide for the ministries that are so important to us and the community in which we serve. As we look to "Connect, Grow & Serve" within and outside our church community, it is important to keep up on our financial support of the operating budget. We have continued to fall behind our 2023 envelope giving targets for year-to-date November by \$34,019 vs. budget and by \$18,277 vs. the same period last year. We are asking you to please prayerfully consider how you might be able to *help close the gap* by the end of 2023.

We had over 160 households participate in the Pavilion Capital Campaign whose generosity helped us to meet our \$300,000 goal for this ministry project. Our Finance Team has received some questions as to whether the Pavilion Capital Campaign impacted giving to Faith's general operating fund by our members. Our contribution data supports that the households that contributed to the Pavilion Capital Campaign have also provided year-to-date gifts to the general operating fund that are collectively above and beyond what they gave to Faith as of the same time last year. In addition, the pavilion project brought 30 new givers to Faith! Look at what God can do!

We would like to extend a heartfelt thank you to the **101 households** who have already submitted their 2024 pledges totaling **\$377,869**. We have extended the submission deadline through the end of January 2024. You can submit your pledge by dropping it in the Concourse pledge box, mailing it to our church office (2576 Browncroft Blvd, Rochester, NY 14625) or calling the church office at 585-381-3970 with your pledge information.

We have also been very blessed to receive a robust response from many of our members indicating the ministries in which they have pledged to participate in the coming year. Exciting times are ahead of us as we embark on this new chapter of ministry together with Pastor Peter and our many ministry teams.

Paul reminds us in 1 Corinthians 4: 1 & 2, "This how is how one should regard us, as servants of Christ and stewards of the mysteries of God. Moreover, it is required of stewards that they be found faithful."



## HOW TO REDUCE TAXABLE INCOME WITH A QUALIFIED CHARITABLE DISTRIBUTION



In an effort to help you be a good steward of the gifts God has given you, we would like to share a strategy that could be a blessing to you, your family, and our Faith family.

The generous standard deduction available for the current tax year is welcomed by many as it will simplify filing and could even reduce your tax bill. Even if you take the standard deduction, however, there is a tax-savvy strategy that allows retirees to further reduce their tax liability by taking advantage of qualified charitable distributions (QCDs) from their individual retirement accounts. This charitable rollover provision allows IRA owners 70 ½ years or older to transfer up to \$100,000 per year directly from their IRA to one or more qualified charities, without that donation being counted as taxable income when it is withdrawn. In addition, these qualified charitable distributions count as part of the person's required withdrawals from the IRA account.

Please consult your tax adviser and IRA trustee to make sure that you meet the qualifications to take advantage of this provision and that the distribution is properly processed.

If you would like to make a qualified charitable distribution to Faith Lutheran Church, please instruct your IRA trustee or custodian to make a transfer from the IRA directly to Faith Lutheran Church as the payee on the check. You may also have the distribution transferred directly from your IRA account to Faith Lutheran Church's checking account by contacting Kay Gerlach in the church office at 485-0412 or finance@faithpenfield.org for the necessary information. Your donation will be credited to support the unified budget of Faith Lutheran Church unless you designate otherwise via written communication to either Kay Gerlach, Director of Finance, or Kris Cronk, Church Secretary.

Please know that we sincerely appreciate any gift you make to support the ministry and mission of Faith Lutheran Church. We are so blessed that God provides so many ways for us to be a part of His work here on earth! May your gifts serve as a reminder that God provides all that you have and has given to us His greatest gift of all – His Son, Jesus who gave His very life for you!
