High School Ministry

Grades 9-10 Held at St. Sebastian Parish

High School Youth Ministry for St. Catherine and St. Sebastian Parishes is focused on helping students in grades 9-10 grow in their knowledge of our faith and in their spirituality. Through catechesis, participation in mass, socializing and community engagement, we strive to provide opportunities for young people to encounter and serve Jesus Christ. High School ministry will focus on teaching young people concrete ways to live out their faith, while guiding them to an understanding of how God and scripture. We are committed to fostering a sense of self, by encouraging them to cultivate a personal relationship with God.



Youth Ministry classes are offered from September through May. They will meet once a month as a small group. They will also meet in a large group setting, once a month, with middle schoolers for Youth Liturgy of the Word. Those sessions will include a meal and attending the 6pm mass leading the liturgical ministries.

Essentially, this age group is in their early stages of Confirmation preparation. Therefore the program aims to prime them for sharing their time, talent and treasure with the parish. As well, provide space for them to cultivate their personal relationship with God. There is a parish requirement to register for confirmation preparation-young people planning to receive this sacrament in grade 11, must be involved in two years of previous catechetical sessions, unless they attend a Catholic high school.

In addition to catechetical instruction, high schoolers will have an opportunity to serve and socialize together. Our goal is for the teens to participate in monthly service projects, either together as a youth group or within their families. We will offer fun social activities; so that we can foster friendships and give them a safe space to empower their individuality. Essential to youth ministry are opportunities to *retreat*, therefore, high school students are expected to attend a one day retreat on February 28, 2026. Details will be provided closer to the date.

Family Faith Formation

An essential part of our formation program are the family sessions, which are intergenerational lessons focused on one topic. We have scheduled six family programs this year, building upon the liturgical calendar and core themes or teachings of the Catholic Church. Each family program involves a fun activity, sharing in community, take-home resources for continued family engagement and learning. All families are expected to participate in the family programs. We hope these sessions are scheduled in a manner that will allow families from both parishes to participate. Family resources for formation at home are always available, please contact any formation minister if you would like materials to do with your family at home! The cost of these six sessions are included in the registration fee. The dates for family formation sessions are also on the calendar attached.

NOTE: Families involved in Youth Ministry will receive regular up-dates, with formation information, and articles related to growing in faith through the email provided on your registration. Communication will also take place through the bulletin and verbal mass announcements. Your high schooler(s) will also receive text messages from Margaret.

Program Fees

Faith Formation fees are designed to defray part of the cost of materials and programs. The fees are a necessity for the programs to occur, however we are committed to providing catechesis to all families, no matter the ability to pay. No one is denied Faith Formation due to an inability to pay fees. If there is a concern, please contact one of the Faith Formation Ministers or Father Peter Patrick to discuss reductions, special arrangements, or waiver of fees.

Fees are the same for participants registered in Catechesis of Good Shepherd, K4-5 Faith Formation and Youth Ministry.

- \$75.00 for one child
- \$150.00 for two children
- \$225.00 for three or more children

Please note:

- Registrations and one-fourth payment of fees are due by September 22st.
- SCRIP credit, if applicable, may be applied to reduce fees.
- Registrations and fees for sacramental preparation, Reconciliation/First Eucharist and Confirmation, are separate registrations.

If you need financial assistance, please reach out to a faith formation minister or Father Peter Patrick to discuss options. We do not want any family to not participate due to finances.

Payment Logistics

Families may choose one of the following payment plans:

- Fee paid in full with registration by September 21st
- Two equal payments: September 21st and January 18th
- Four equal payments: September 21st, November 30th, January 18th, and March 15th
