"Gathering Disciples Divinely Interrupts Lives!"
[Matthew 4:18-22 Mark 1:16-20; Luke 5:1-11]

INTRODUCTION
WHO LIKES TO BE INTEERRUPTED?
Did you know that there were interruptions and unexpected moments in Christ's ministry? YES \Box / NO \Box
Jesus's reaction to the people and disruptions that occur around him help us recognize that God is
Jesus' ministry was characterized by both plans and also (seemingly) interruptions.
MAIN POINTS
Have you ever thought that by initially calling the disciples to follow Him, Jesus was divinely (like royally) interrupting many lives. YES □ / NO □ Matthew 4:18-22 and Mark 1:16-20 DID YOU HEAR WHAT JUST HAPPENED THERE!?
So Jesus says to them, "Come with me. I'll make a new kind of fisherman out of you. I'll show you how to catch and instead of perch and bass." That is a very weird comment!
What in heaven's name is a fisher of people!?
NOW DID YOU SEE THE REACTION HERE? How many ?'s did they ask?
What Pete and Andy do here?

they came upon
The Bible records that it was the with James & John, Zebedee's sons, as it was with their coworker Simon
(Notice that Father Zebedee wasn't called to join, OR he didn't go & join in this weird little parade of followers with Jesus!)
Mark 1:20 even recalls that the brothers James and John, Zebedee's sons were in the boat mending their fishnets when <u>Jesus made the EXACT same offer</u>
The two groups of brothers, Simon and Andrew and James and John followed Jesus to from Him, to be by Him!
In Luke 5:1-11 (NLT) there is yet another account of an experience of Jesus encountering
Verse 4 of Luke 5 recalls that when He finished teaching, He said to Simon, " out into deep water and let your nets out for a"
Simon said, "Master, we've been fishing hard all night and haven't caught even a But if you say so, I'll let out the nets."
Luke 5:8 records that Simon Peter, when he saw it, fell to his knees before Jesus. "Master, leave. I'm a and can't handle this Leave me to myself."
WHAT A RESPONSE TO THIS MIRACLE AND THE PRESENCE OF CHRIST!
PETER'S CARNALITY & SELF-CENTREDNESS IS CONFRONTED BY JESUS' PURITY!!
Then Jesus said pivotal words to Simon
"Don't be From now on you will for people" (Lk 5:10)
Luke 5:11 records the outflow of the inner big shift in the fisherman's lives.

Luke writes under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit that "then they left and followed him." These crusty guys were being made by Jesus!!!!!
I want to review here: Luke 5:10-11 recalls that Jesus said to Simon, "There is <u>nothing to</u> ."
WHEN JESUS CALLS US TO BE DISCIPLES, HE LEADS US TO EVENTUAL ETERNAL WHOLENESS & HEALTH THROUGH HUMBLE OBEDIENCE.

CONCLUSION 4 Key Take-Aways
As recorded in the Bible, Jesus interrupted the lives of the people He and asked to follow Him and be His disciples.
The disciples also (in a way) interrupted the life of Jesus by Him, but it was a welcome interruption!
 Jesus also interrupts the lives of you and me today when He shows up in our lives and asks us to turn from our sins,, & live for Him!
 And we also (in a way) interrupt Jesus by turning to Him and asking for Him to help us to be His!!

WHO IS JESUS INTERRUPTING YOUR LIFE WITH TODAY!?
