Sermon "Crumbs"

"On their way" This phrase at the beginning of today's sermon text (Mark 10:32) reminds us that we're in the journey-to-Jerusalem section of the gospel. Mark tells this part of the Jesus story, a literal geographical journey, in a way that stresses the necessity of following the Master "on the way."

"What was going to happen to him" (verse 32) This is the third time in Mark that Jesus prepares his disciples for his coming passion and resurrection. The previous episodes are in chapters 8 and 9.
