CONGREGATIONAL MEETING

September 7 Congregational Vote On September 7 immediately following the worship service the congregation of Christ Community Church will vote on calling our next Senior Pastor. Pastor Jon Wiziarde has been presented to the congregation as a candidate for the position of Senior Pastor by the Seach Committee and Elder Board.

According to our Constitution, the decision to call a Senior Pastor is made by a secret ballot vote at a business meeting for which announcements have been made at least four Sundays before the meeting. Calling a Senior Pastor requires a three-fourths majority vote of members present at a legally constituted meeting.

Who are voting members of Christ Community Church? According to Elder Board Policy people officially become members of the church at the moment the Board of Elders votes them into membership. So, how do you know if you are a voting member? All members of CCC have filled out an application form and submitted it to a Pastor or Elder. You would have had an interview with a Pastor and Elder and then received a letter from the church informing you the Elder Board accepted your application and voted to affirm you as a member of the church.

We are grateful for everyone who is a part of the CCC family whether you are a member or regular attender. The congregational vote to call a Senior Pastor is for those who have been affirmed as members of the church. We will be relying on you to know your membership status. If you are not sure if you are a church member or if you don't recall completing the process described above, please contact Pastor Mike or Pastor Drew.

Do I have to be present to vote? The answer is Yes, you must be present to vote at a congregational meeting. The constitution of CCC says, "Calling a Senior Pastor requires a three-fourths majority vote of <u>members present</u> at a legally constituted meeting."

Sample Ballot:

As a voting member of Christ Community Church I affirm that Pastor Jon Wiziarde should become the Senior Pastor of the Christ Community Church.

- 4. We discussed and reviewed a list of potential candidates to serve on the Camp Leadership Team.
- 5. We discussed and reviewed the proposal from the Camp Leadership Team for the Gathering Place loan repayment.
- 6. The Elder Board commissioned a study to review the compensation for all paid staff. The study is complete and the information was distributed to the Elder Board for review.
