Percussion has lent its energy to praise music at least since Miriam led the women of Israel in celebrating their liberation from Egypt through singing, dancing, and playing tambourines. Hidden in this story is the fact that instruments were so important to the Israelites that they HAD tambourines, even in bondage, and one of the first things they did when they got their freedom was to break them out and play. If your kids have ever been inspired to praise the Lord on the drums but you've been somewhat less inspired to keep a drum set in the house, you might be happy to know that practice pads offer a much quieter alternative. The Conservatory has a drum room and accomplished drum teacher waiting to help them shape their tendency to bang on everything in the house into a more jubilant sound.
