The Bible is very clear about who gets baptized. In the book of Acts Peter tells the people that they need to repent and be baptized!

Once we accept Jesus we too should be baptized. Our baptism doesn't save us - Jesus already did that!

But baptism does show something very important.

WHY DO YOU THINK WE SHOULD BE BAPTIZED?

Baptism is a picture of two things:

GOING DOWN IN THE WATER:

Dying with Christ. Not actually dying, but a symbol of us putting our sins behind us and not living for the world anymore.

GOING UP OUT OF THE WATER:

Living for Christ! Proclaiming that you want to live for Jesus. The cross before you, the things of the world behind you! Your sins have been washed away and you have been made new!

BAPTISM IS A CELEBRATION! IT IS US SHOWING THE WORLD THAT WE HAVE DECIDED TO LIVE FOR JESUS!
