Eucharistic Procession

Next Sunday, June 7 we will celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi). Immediately following the 9am Mass, a Eucharistic Procession will take place from church to Central Park and back. The Eucharistic procession acts as a public proclamation of our Catholic belief in the Real Presence of Christ in the Blessed Sacrament. It also emphasizes the move from Mass to mission – that



the Eucharistic celebration sends the faith community into the world to engage in the ministry of evangelization. Christ accompanies us on our pilgrimage of faith. We proclaim Him and the Gospel message as our life, hope, and peace. Please plan to join this solemn procession if you can walk this short route. We will need 2 servers (may be adults) and 4 men to carry the canopy for the Blessed Sacrament. Please let Ken know in advance if you can assist in either of these roles.

Missionary Appeal

Next weekend, at all masses, Rev. Raju Pilla and Rev. Jacob Stellus will be speaking about the works and the needs of the Latin Archdiocese of Trivandrum in India. Trivandrum has about 2,80,000 Catholics. 90% of the people belongs to fishermen community, majority of whom depends on fishing for their livelihood. 10% are farm workers who are recent converts from low caste Hindus. Unemployment and poverty are most rampant in the communities. The archdiocese depends on outside contributions to support its clergy, seminarians, catechists, and the humanitarian projects of the homes for the orphans, aged and destitute, which provide food, shelter, medicine, and education. In 2021, Hurricane "Tauktae" left hundreds of families homeless. Monsoon sea-erosion each year, destroys several homes of the fishermen who live near the sea and make a living from fishing. The archdiocese tries to provide a few most deserving families with housing every year. We humbly request your generous contribution to the second collection. Your sacrifice for the Missions is deeply appreciated. May God bless you.

As we celebrated the coming of the Holy Spirit last Sunday at Pentecost, it is now fitting that we celebrate the Holy Trinity, God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit. It is one of the mysteries of our faith that our God is one and three persons at the same time. That may be difficult for us to comprehend, as we daily try to grasp with who we are as individual beings. Today's Gospel begins with one of the most quoted verses in the New Testament, "God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life," otherwise known as John 3:16 and seen on posters and signs at sporting events around the world. The solemnity that we celebrate is wrapped in this verse, for the love that the Father shares with the Son is the same Holy Spirit that we call on whenever we are in need, no matter what that need may be.
