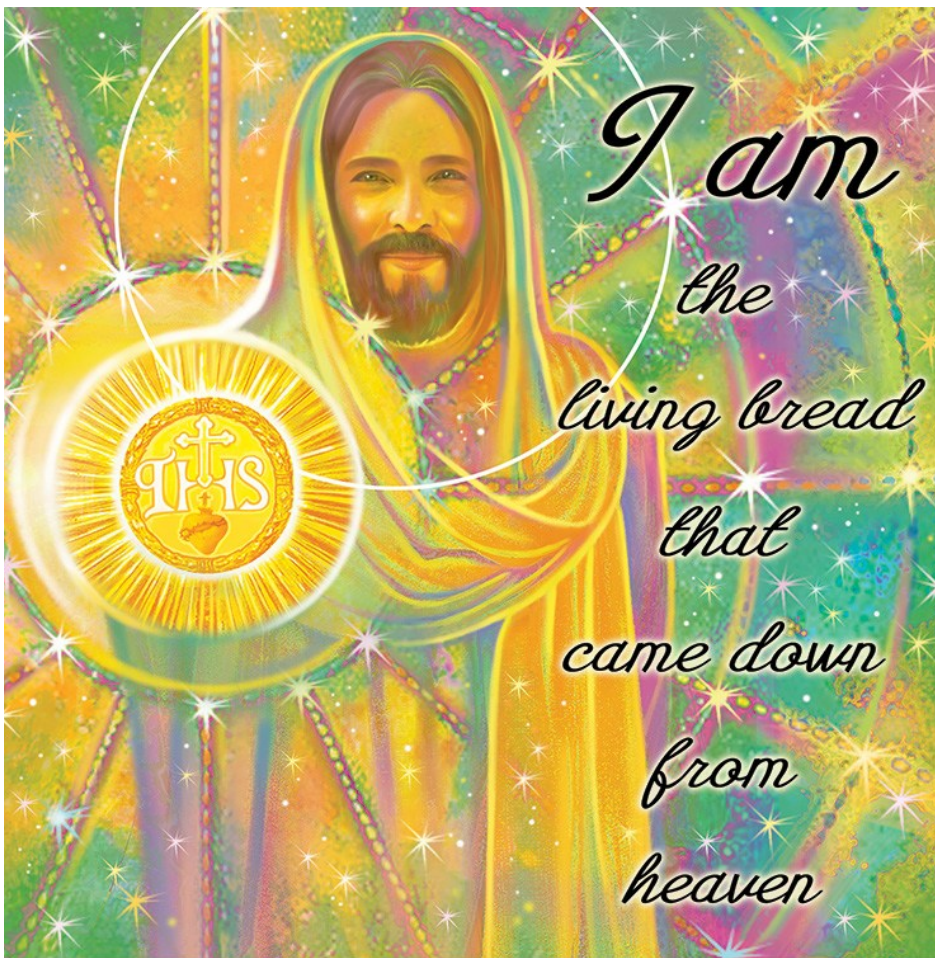

Today we celebrate the solemnity (highest feast) of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. Despite being back in Ordinary Time, we celebrated the Holy Trinity last week and now another significant feast this week. This will be the last large celebration on Sunday until we get to November. The feast we celebrate today is one that is central to our faith and beliefs. It sets us apart from many Christian denominations. It is the source and summit of all we profess. If we had to pick only one aspect of our faith to focus on, this would be the one. Before Jesus died, he offered us his Body and Blood to share for all times and asked us to celebrate the Eucharist in memory of Him. Jesus makes himself available to us, if only we will allow him to come and live within us. It is at the same time such a simple idea, and yet one that needs to be reflected on for as long as we live.
