

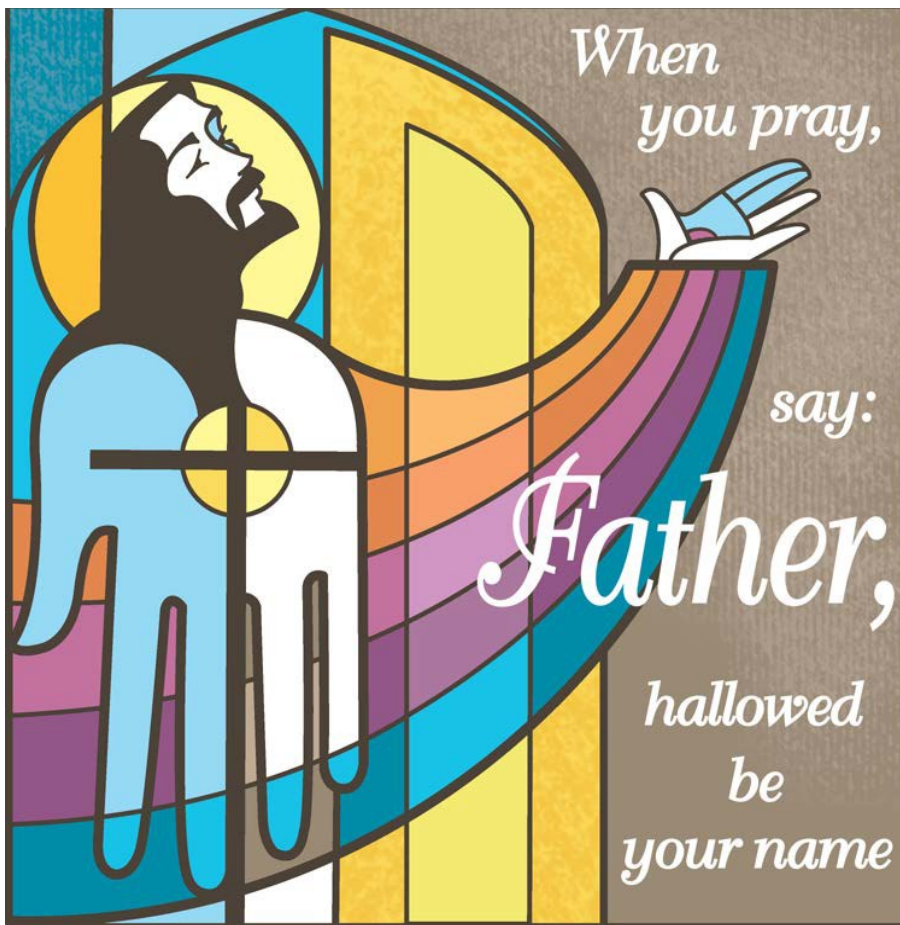

In today's Gospel Jesus teaches us how to pray and tells us that we need only ask in order to receive. We want to believe, yet so many times we have asked and have not received, or so it seems. Many of our prayers have been sincere, for needs that have not been selfish, but for the well-being of others. Why were those prayers not answered? As much as we really want to know, we may not learn this in our lifetime. In the Our Father we pray "thy kingdom come, thy will be done". Why doesn't God want to answer my prayer? He does! But the understanding of God is far beyond our own, without limits, and beyond working within our limited days on earth. God does not want us to despair and give up. He wants us to be persistent in our asking. We are assured that God hears all our prayers. We are told that the Father will give the Holy Spirit to all who ask him. When was the last time you included that request in your prayer?

Limited supplies will also be available at the August 12th Back to School Resource Fair.



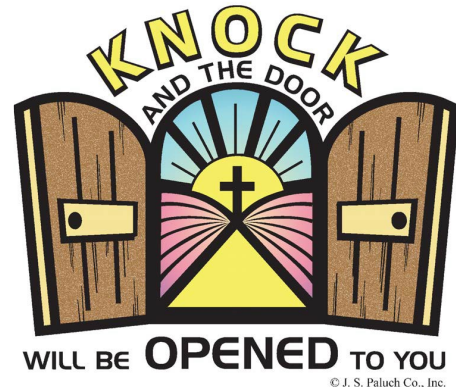
