We have to choose what we will do, and also if we understand that our plans may not happen as we expected. James reminds us of this concept:

James 4:13 Now listen, you who say, "Today or tomorrow we will go to this or that city, spend a year there, carry on business and make money." 14 Why, you do not even know what will happen tomorrow. What is your life? You are a mist that appears for a little while and then vanishes. 15 Instead, you ought to say, "If it is the Lord's will, we will live and do this or that." 16 As it is, you boast in your arrogant schemes. All such boasting is evil. 17 If anyone, then, knows the good they ought to do and doesn't do it, it is sin for them.

We can plan ahead, but if we do not involve the Lord in the plans... we will be upset when things go awry. This life is going to have things happen that change everything we think we should do. Sometimes, we need to change our plans in order to do the good/right thing. Someone needs help at their house, and it doesn't fit in our plans. We should go help if at all possible. What if we see a homeless person on our way into Walmart? Should we stop and bring them food on our way back out? Yeah, we should. We see someone while we are out and could invite them to church with us. We should swallow our fear and pride and ask. Who knows what that question may start in someone's life? What we see in verse 17 is that we are held accountable for knowing about the good we could be doing and should do, and ignore it and go and do our own thing, we are sinning. We are missing out on what the Lord had set before us because we had our own plans and did not step up to the plate like God wanted us to do.
