Graduation is almost here! A time of moving from one spot in life to another. We have moments in our lives where things change. A new job, a new school, a new car, a new spouse, a new house, a new kid, etc.

We all have things come up in life where change happens. There is always going to be something that adjusts what goes on in our lives. How do we deal with it? Panic, frustration, excitement? Jesus has a bit to say about how we handle change and what is happening in our lives:

Matthew 6:25 “Therefore I tell you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat or drink; or about your body, what you will wear. Is not life more than food, and the body more than clothes? **26** Look at the birds of the air; they do not sow or reap or store away in barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not much more valuable than they? **27** Can any one of you by worrying add a single hour to your life? **28** And why do you worry about clothes? See how the flowers of the field grow. They do not labor or spin. **29** Yet I tell you that not even Solomon in all his splendor was dressed like one of these. **30** If that is how God clothes the grass of the field, which is here today and tomorrow is thrown into the fire, will he not much more clothe you—you of little faith? **31** So do not worry, saying, ‘What shall we eat?’ or ‘What shall we drink?’ or ‘What shall we wear?’ **32** For the pagans run after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them. **33** But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well. **34** Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own.”

This passage is about worry, but so often when change happens, that is not change that we decided upon, we start to panic or get upset and frustrated. Then there are those small groups of the population that get excited about the change. They are a bit crazy but also very blessed.

When things change, what do you do? Does the stress get high? We tend to panic and try to control things, and Jesus tells us: Whoa. Hold on. God has you. This life is more than just the physical. The mental, emotional, and spiritual are all connected. If you are connected in good and healthy relationship with Jesus, then you will find calmness and even excitement in what the Lord is doing in the coming days and weeks.

Pause and reflect on what change may be coming and when it does hit and surprises you, thank God for this new opportunity, and ask for His help to navigate this new situation.

We throw parties for graduates to celebrate their accomplishments, but also help them through the transition. They recognize the change, and it is put as positive in front of them with relatives and friends, cake, and presents. What do you do when change hits?
