June is here! Camp is here, and all the summer activities. Vacations, trips, swimming days, and everything else in between. It's a wonderful time for students, but then we adults still have in between these special events, where we fit them in, work... There are still things to do, but what is important is finding time to rest and reflect. Why do we take vacations? So we can pause our normal routine and reset. We need moments of pausing and reflection.

What is important in the midst of taking breaks is not to take a break from the Lord. In those moments away from work and the normal insanity of life, do not pause your walk with the Lord. He is the place where you should find your rest and peace. David understood that:

Psalm 62:5 Yes, my soul, find rest in God; my hope comes from him. **6** Truly he is my rock and my salvation; he is my fortress, I will not be shaken.

David pauses things in his life, but he doesn't pause his relationship with God. It is, in fact, when he slows down is when he has his biggest heart-to-heart conversations with God. He gets that he needs to spend more time with the Creator, or else things will get more insane than when they started. God is the source that calms things down in your heart, soul, mind, and even your strength. It does not mean that the storm stops, but it means you are focused in the proper way. Jesus got this:

Luke 6:12 One of those days Jesus went out to a mountainside to pray, and spent the night praying to God.

Any of us stay up all night talking to God? I have done a couple of hours some nights sporadically, and that was difficult. It was also helpful. I was not going to be sleeping anyway. My heart, mind, and spirit were troubled. I would rather sit with God in His presence than just tossing and turning in my own thoughts. Jesus understood the connection that needs to happen to the Lord daily and consistently and taught that to His disciples.

I want to leave you with this passage where Jesus walks on water, and then Peter does as well. Notice how Peter can operate while focused on Jesus, but also notice what Jesus does before He walks on water:

Matthew 14:22 Immediately Jesus made the disciples get into the boat and go on ahead of him to the other side, while he dismissed the crowd. **23** *After he had dismissed them, he went up on a mountainside by himself to pray. Later that night, he was there alone,* **24** and the boat was already a considerable distance from land, buffeted by the waves because the wind was against it. **25** Shortly before dawn Jesus went out to them, walking on the lake. **26** When the disciples saw him walking on the lake, they were terrified. "It's a ghost," they said, and cried out in fear. **27** But Jesus immediately said to them: "Take courage! It is I. Don't be afraid."

28 "Lord, if it's you," Peter replied, "tell me to come to you on the water." **29** "Come," he said. Then Peter got down out of the boat, walked on the water and came toward Jesus. **30** *But when he saw the wind, he was afraid and, beginning to sink, cried out, "Lord, save me!"* **31** *Immediately Jesus reached out his hand and caught him. "You of little faith," he said, "why did you doubt?"* **32** And when they climbed into the boat, the wind died down. **33** Then those who were in the boat worshiped him, saying, "Truly you are the Son of God."

Are you and I resting in the Lord and keeping our eyes on Him during our lives and even when the storms hit?
