Howdy, church family. We are close to VBS and the close of summer once again. A lot has happened this summer with trips, events, and changes. I think we can all agree that we have been in several storms over the past several months. It reminds me of a parable Jesus told:

Matthew 7:24 "Therefore everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock. **25** The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house; yet it did not fall, because it had its foundation on the rock. **26** But everyone who hears these words of mine and does not put them into practice is like a foolish man who built his house on sand. **27** The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house, and it fell with a great crash."

This parable is an important one as it gives us a lot of spiritual application. We can talk about the foundation of God in a person's life versus the foundation a person puts up on their own and how rickety that is. We can talk about the house having to be built by both parties. The big topic though for today is this: which of the two experiences storms in life? The answer is simple in the parable: both experience storms. It is not that storms do not happen to Christians. In fact, if it is a Satan led storm, it will be much worse for the Christian. Why? Satan has already got the non-Christian where he wants them. He wants them comfortable and happy. But even for the non-Christian, things can happen. Loss of a friend or family member. A broken bone. A relationship is broken. Things in this world happen. The storms hit both people. How we handle things is so much tied to which foundation we have built our life upon and also that we have put in the effort to build the house. You put your trust in God as your foundation and then you have to study His Word and learn things from it in order to build the house.

Can you build the house of your life without God? Well a lot of people have. Does it hold up well under stress? We see even in the parable and in everyday life, that that person's life crumbles. The foundation is weak and so the house is weak as well.

God did not promise we would not have storms. He promised to give us the firm foundation and asks us to start building. Have you built your life on the firm foundation? Are you ready for the storms that are going to show tomorrow, Wednesday, next month, and in a year or two?
