A WORD FROM YOUR PASTOR...

UPDATE REGARDING OUR STAFFING NEEDS:

As we continue the process of evaluating and filling our staff needs, let me inform or remind you of how our bylaws address this process: *“Candidates for ministerial staff positions shall be sought and interviewed by the pastor and the personnel committee. For the purposes of conducting the search for a ministerial associate, the personnel committee may be augmented with persons knowledgeable about the needs and qualifications for a particular position. Such persons shall be appointed by the moderator and approved by the congregation in a business meeting.”*

The personnel committee has met twice and had far-ranging discussions about the immediate and long-range staffing needs for our congregation. We also had a listening session with students and will continue to solicit their input. We are grateful for the adults who are stepping up in student leadership, worship leadership, discipleship, technology, and other areas that Josh worked in. Because of their service, we have the opportunity to see the “big picture” and be deliberate and prayerful in our task. A staff vacancy is a challenge—but also an opportunity. Our priority now is for the Spirit to guide us in determining the areas of ministry that need to be addressed so we can be specific in our search parameters. We intend soon to have a recommendation regarding persons to add to the committee for the purposes of this search. Our personnel committee consists of Chaundra Young, Gordon Williams, Justin Keown, Shawn Whitis, Sandra Young, and Donetta Crawford. 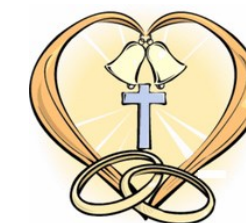
