## CAMP PHONE NUMBER

This number will be given out close to the start of camp. Please program this phone number in your cell phone.

This is the phone number that will come up if we need to call you for any reason.

## **EARLY PICKUP**

If possible, please let us know at MORNING DROP OFF that you will be picking up early & an approximate time. You can also text the camp phone with early pickup info during the day. We appreciate when we have a heads up- especially if you are picking up around swim times.

**NO EARLY PICKUPS ARE ALLOWED BETWEEN 3:30-4:00** 



## MORNING DROP OFF

#### **CARLINE DROP OFF (7AM-9AM)**

Beginning at 7am there will be a camp director in the back parking lot to greet you and your child and sign them in for the day.

You will NOT have to exit your car if you drop off between 7am and 9am.

#### **LATE DROP OFF (AFTER 9AM)**

If you drop off after 9am- please park and walk your child to the pavilion and see a director to sign them in. You will not be allowed to leave your child with a counselor- they have been instructed to send you to a director for proper check in. Children are NOT ALLOWED walk themselves down from the parking lot after 9am under any circumstances.



## END OF DAY PICK UP

#### **CARLINE PICK UP (4PM-6PM)**

Beginning at 4pm there will be a camp director in the back parking lot to assist with pick up. Please be sure to have your hang tag displayed in your vehicle. The bag tag on your camper's bag must match the number on the hang tag in order for us to release that child to you.

If you do not have your hang tag you will need to produce your drivers license for us to check against the list of people allowed to pick up your child (collected from your application info).

#### **EARLY PICK UP (BEFORE 4PM)**

If possible, please let us know at MORNING DROP OFF that you will be picking up early & an approximate time. You can also text the camp phone with early pickup info during the day. We appreciate when we have a heads up- so we have time to have your child ready- especially if you are picking up around swim times.

NO EARLY PICKUPS ARE ALLOWED BETWEEN 3:30-4:00


Our late pickup fees are not negotiable. You must pay at pick up or bring cash the next morning at drop off for any late pick up fees in order for your child to attend camp that day. Please understand that someone had to stay late to be here with your child and was not able to get home to their family.

#### **RAINY DAY PICK UP**

For days when it is rainy, excessively hot or there is a home swim team meet, please note the covered entrances along the back of the church. There are 3 we use on those days. Counselors and Directors will be stationed at each exit both inside and outside. The first covered awning closest to the playground will be for Youth pick up, the middle covered exit is for 6/7s pickup and the covered awning labeled "Office" will be for 8/9s and 10/11s.



## MUSICAL PERFORMANCE

## CAMP BAG CONTENTS

#### LABEL! LABEL! LABEL!

- Camp Bag
- Large Carabiner (attached to camp bag so it can be hooked onto the fence)
- Swimsuit (have your child wear a swimsuit every day, even if they say they are not going to swim. Tankinis ARE allowed, Bikinis are NOT allowed)
- Swim shirt (A long or short sleeve swim shirt with UPF protection is VERY STRONGLY recommended.)
- SUNSCREEN! (We only allow LOTION sunscreens for all ages. Please NO SPRAY!)
- Sunscreen Face Stick
- Tennis shoes (Tennis shoes MUST be worn every day for the safety of your child's feet.)
- Water shoes (These are not required but HIGHLY recommended.)
- Towel
- Change of clothes (in a large ziplock bag)
- Reusable Water Bottle LABELED with your child's name
- Large Lunch Box or small cooler



## TIPS:

- LABEL EVERYTHING!! We make every effort to return lost itemsand a lost and found will be kept. However, if items are labeledwe can return them directly to your child at camp.
- APPLY SUNSCREEN TO YOUR CHILD BEFORE THEY ARRIVE EVERY DAY!
- Send a water bottle EVERY DAY!!! If you forget one at homeplease stop and buy a large bottled water for them to use that day. We will label it for them at camp.
- Pack extra food for your child- they are hungrier than you think!
- Buy inexpensive beach towels and use bleach to bleach your child's name as large as possible on the towel.
