How can you prepare for the season? First, read all of the scripture passages and meditate on each one. How is God speaking to you through these divinely inspired words? Second, try to figure out which passage corresponds to the word "we don't want to hear"? Then, come every week and see if you have paired them correctly.

As an extra bonus, these psalms will also be used during Lent: 6, 32, 38, 130, 143. They are referred to as the "Penitential Psalms." Read these in advance as well as part of your season of repentance.

LENTEN OFFERINGS

The Lenten offerings will be divided equally among the following four recipients:

Malawi Orphan Care Project - The project exists to improve the lives of orphaned and at-risk children and their caregivers in Malawi, Africa. Their vision is to have healthy, self-sustaining communities throughout Malawi. The project works with community leaders to address the physical, spiritual, economic, and relational needs of the orphans and their care givers.

Rantoul Food Bank - They are a non-profit organization that provides food to families at or below poverty level. They average serving approximately 500 families per month.

NALC - Theological Education Fund - This fund supports the NALC's efforts to provide for faithful Lutheran theological education for its pastors, prospective pastors and lay people. It also provides support for operational funding and scholarship support for seminarians.

Living Alternatives Pregnancy Resource

Center - The center offers free testing to all types of women. Most come to us in a crisis. Other services include parenting classes and providing maternity and baby clothing.
