2019 PROJECTS:

VALLEY LIFE DISCIPLESHIP HOME, \$12,000

DESCRIPTION: Valley Life is a 6 month structured living program in Belle Vernon, PA, that will assist men in gaining stability as they transition from rehab back into society. Their discipleship home is designed to assist clients in early stages of recovery, providing a safe and stable environment, as they work towards obtaining long-term sobriety. Valley Life wants to help men find true freedom, through more than just abstaining from drugs and alcohol, but living the functional, healthy life that God intended for each of them.

USE OF FUNDS: New vehicle to transport men, finish flooring & furnishing in group counseling room, and resources for weekly life skills groups.

LIVING IN LIBERTY, \$12,000

DESCRIPTION: Living in Liberty offers a secure safe house for victims of human sex trafficking and does street outreach with victims on the streets. Living in Liberty also educates the community at large about sex trafficking, its prevalence worldwide, and its presence in our own communities. Women rescued from commercial sexual exploitation live at a safe house at an undisclosed location in the Greater Pittsburgh area. There they receive a range of services in a loving, caring environment, including emotional and spiritual support, healthcare, education and skills training, food, clothing, legal counseling, and more.

USE OF FUNDS: A new safe house in the Northside of Pittsburgh

REVITALIZE, \$12,000

DESCRIPTION: The goal of Revitalize is to help pastors and churches take steps toward health in turning around struggling churches.

USE OF FUNDS: Through this project, Revitalize would be providing smaller micro-grants to revitalizing churches that could be used to help paint a foyer, purchase some media equipment or even possibly purchase kids ministry curriculum.

BEVERLY'S BIRTHDAYS, \$12,000

DESCRIPTION: Beverly's Birthdays provides birthday cheer for children experiencing homelessness and families in need. They believe that every child, regardless of personal or financial circumstances, deserves a very special birthday. Beverly's Birthdays services over 20,000 children annually through six programs, including Birthday Parties, Birthday Presents, Itty Bitty Birthday Cheer (for newborns and new moms), Birthday-in-a-Bag (for students at schools), The Birthday Boutique (a mobile fashion truck for parties), and Classroom Cheer (kits for teachers).

USE OF FUNDS: Itty Bitty Birthday Cheer Program, which provides birthday cheer bins filled with essential items for newborn babies, and works with agencies to host group baby showers.
