HE NEVER HAS FAILED

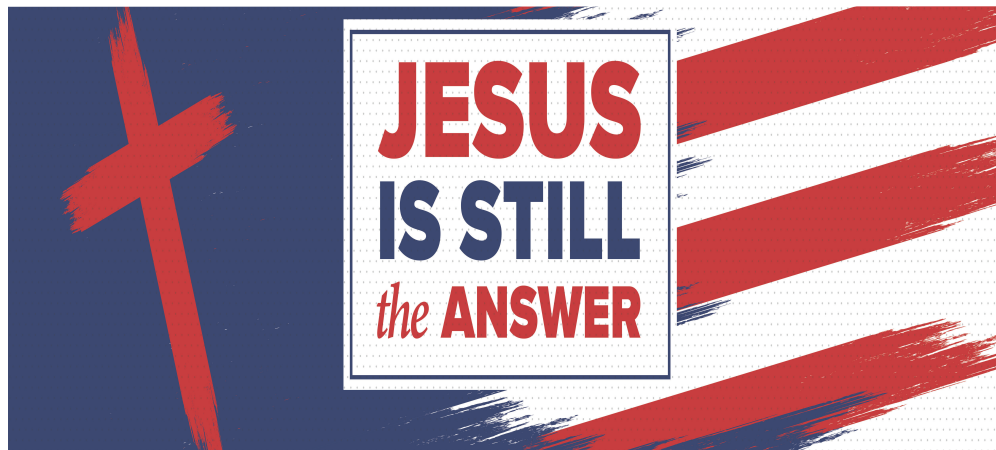
When I travel the pathway so rugged and steep,
