We are so excited about NIB 2025! Last year went great and we expect this year to be even better!

If you call Stoney Creek Church home, partner with us and volunteer for this outreach event. This is a church-wide event and we can use ALL AGES! Many volunteers will be needed for each night of the event and we will need some to help with tasks ahead of time to prepare, too!

If you're new to Stoney Creek, you may be asking what IS Night in Bethlehem? Night in Bethlehem (NIB) is a live Nativity and more. It is an outdoor, walking journey that will take visitors back to the time when Jesus was born. They will experience the sights, sounds and smells as they interact with the merchants, carpenters, bakers, Roman soldiers and others. They will feed the animals, see the camel and get warm by the fire. They will enjoy some refreshments in the Inn (if there is any room) and finally, visit the manger and witness the new born child, Jesus! Kids get to participate in hands on activities and gather goodies along the way.
