<u>Ladies Bible Study</u> When You Pray: A Study of Six Prayers in the Bible (Room 206)

- Facilitators: Melanie Watson, Brittany Laughrun, & Lisa Williamson
- **Structure:** Each session includes a 25-40 minute video, and group discussion. Also included is 6 weeks of personal study (between each session).
- **Focus:** The study delves into six specific prayers found in the Bible, providing examples of how to pray and offering guidance on various prayer styles like praise, lament, and intercession.
- **Goals:** The study aims to help participants understand the purpose of prayer, learn how to pray effectively, and overcome challenges in their prayer life.
- **Key themes:** The study explores themes like the importance of prayer in uniting believers, the different ways to approach God in prayer (praise, lament, etc.), and the power of prayer to strengthen faith and deepen one's relationship with Christ.
