"Again, he took the Twelve aside and told them what was going to happen to him. 'We are going to Jerusalem, Jesus said and the Son of Man will be delivered over to the chief priests. They will condemn him to death and will hand him over to the Gentiles, who will mock him and spit on him, flog him and kill him. Three days later he will rise." (Mark 10). Notice the following phrase again, "We are going to Jerusalem." Jesus not only knew his destination, but also his destiny. In other words, Christ had a single purpose and he was determined to not only move towards it, but complete it.

We have begun the journey to the cross and the tomb. One of the challenges in traveling with Jesus is trusting His leadership to an unknown future. uncertainty, our growing fears increase because we don't know what lies ahead. We must believe in the One who holds the future and set our gaze on the direction he invites us to travel. And those steps require prayer. A prayer that has had profound influence in helping shape my own journey is a prayer by Thomas Merton and I offer it to you today. May it help point and empower you as you make the Lenten journey towards Golgotha and beyond.

"My Lord God, I have no idea where I am going. I do not see the road ahead of me. I cannot know for certain where it will end, nor do I really know myself; and the fact I think I am following your will does not mean that I am actually doing so. But I believe that the desire to please you does in fact please you. And I hope I have the desire in all I am doing. I hope that I will I never do anything apart from that desire. And I know that if I do this you will lead me by the right road, though I may know nothing about it. Therefore, I will trust you always though I may seem to be lost and in the shadow of death. I will not fear for you are ever with me and you will never leave me to face my perils alone."

May the love of Christ be your companion...it is the key that opens the doors to this season. I look forward to worshipping with you this Sunday! Blessings,
