Position Purpose:

The Non-Traditional Worship Leader helps fulfill the church's mission by planning and leading engaging, Spirit-filled non-traditional worship experiences that invite people to encounter God and grow as disciples of Jesus Christ. This position builds and leads a team of musicians and vocalists, collaborates with staff on worship planning, and ensures that the non-traditional worship is vibrant, meaningful, and well-coordinated.

Key Responsibilities:**1. Worship Planning & Leadership**

- Plan, coordinate, and lead weekly non-traditional worship service at 11am on Sunday mornings in collaboration with the Senior Pastor and worship planning team.
- Select music that aligns with sermon themes, church seasons, and the mission of the church.
- Lead worship vocally and/or instrumentally with authenticity and excellence.
- Ensure smooth flow of worship through coordination with Tech team and other service participants.

2. Team Building & Development

- Recruit, rehearse, and mentor volunteer musicians and vocalists.
- Foster a positive, prayerful, and collaborative team culture.
- Schedule worship team members via Planning Center and communicate plans effectively.

3. Technical & Creative Support

- Coordinate with the tech team for sound and media to ensure high-quality worship experiences.
- Contribute creative ideas to enhance worship through music, visuals, and other elements.
- Maintain and update worship materials (music charts, lyric slides, service outlines).

4. Collaboration & Ministry Support

- Participate in worship planning meetings and collaborate with staff for special services (Advent, Lent, Easter, Christmas, etc.).

- Support church-wide events or services that include contemporary music as needed.
