Please pray that God would assist and allow these to be fruitful. Also, continue to pray that all the ministries will continue to grow in grace and in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ; and for the continuing Pastor's conferences and Women's conferences.

Personal/Malawi Needs

Our visas are still in process; please be in prayer these get approved without any problems. Also, that we may apply for permanent residence when we arrive to Malawi.

Malawi was rated the poorest country this year. The Malawian people are suffering from severe inflation, resulting in starvation and some unrest. The election is complete, and a new (yet former) president has been elected to office. Pray for him for wisdom and discernment on how to help Malawi and the people.

Furthermore, pray for religious peace to continue and for the gospel of Jesus Christ to grow in the people's hearts resulting in the salvation of many souls and the training of more disciples.
