Cost

\$350 per person, which includes lodging, meals, staffing, and local transportation while serving at Ysleta. This amount does not include travel to and from El Paso. Financial assistance is available upon request. The true cost of the trip is \$700 per participant, but Family of Christ subsidizes half that amount to make the experience more accessible. If you're able and willing to cover the full cost, your generosity helps us extend our impact through Ysleta even further.

Age Requirements

This is an inter-generational friendly event and is suitable for people ages 10-110. Young people under 15, however are to have a parent attend with them.

Transportation

Participants are responsible for their own transportation to and from El Paso, Texas. Whether you choose to fly or drive you are welcome to coordinate with other participants from Family of Christ. Local transportation during the week to various work projects is provided by Ysleta.

Lodging and meals

Our group will stay at the Ysleta Bunkhouse in El Paso, Texas. This facility includes a variety of sleeping options, a kitchen, showers, and a group meeting space. Meals will be provided on-site and feature delicious, authentic Mexican cuisine.

Registration

Registration is due at least eight weeks prior to trip. A **\$100.00** per person deposit is due at that time. Balance for the trip is due before departure.

Travel Documents

Those working in Mexico will need to obtain a passport, passport card or enhanced drivers license prior to the trip. Passport cards can be processed in about 4 weeks.

Planning Meetings:

All registered participants are to attend scheduled pre-event meeting to prepare for the trip. The kick off meeting for the November trip will take place on **September 1 at 6:30pm** and the kick off meeting for the February trip will take place on **December 1 at 6:30pm**.
