Getting Ready for Easter

Lesson 4 Jesus Dies on the Cross (Believe)

We will hear the story of Jesus' entry into Jerusalem and the week leading to his death on the cross. They will understand that if we believe in Jesus, we receive the gift of salvation.

Lesson 5 Jesus Rises from the Dead (Tell)

Preschoolers will hear the joyous story of Mary visiting Jesus' tomb and hearing from an angel that He has risen from the dead, just as He said! God wants them to tell others the good news about Jesus' death and resurrection.

Lesson 1: Be Prepared

Through the story of John the Baptist, preschool children will learn what it means to prepare their hearts for Jesus.

Lesson 4: Fellowship
