

Holy Week at Family of Christ

We can't wait to worship our Savior with you throughout Holy Week.

Holy Week begins with Palm Sunday on March 24. As we commemorate Christ's triumphant entry into Jerusalem, feel free to join us for a Family Worship service at either 9am or 10:30am. Education will still take place during both services, but your family is invited to also bring your children to worship for a kid's processional of palms, a Children's Message, and more!

Holy Week continues with the remembrance of Jesus' last supper with His disciples on Maundy Thursday, **March 28**, **at 6:15pm**. Join us as we set the stage for the passion of our Lord, partake in Holy Communion together, and witness many of our youth gather at this meal for the first time.

Join us on Good Friday, **March 29**, as we experience what a beautiful, but difficult evening it was for our Savior to conquer the power of sin and death through His own suffering on the cross. Join us for a service of Word and Tenebrae (which means darkness) at **6:15pm**.

We love having your little ones worship with us. However, we understand how challenging the content and darkness of Good Friday can be for children. So each year we design a child-friendly Good Friday service at **10am** where children can experience the message of the cross through age appropriate activities, object lessons, and music. If you're an adult and the traditional Good Friday service is too intense for you, feel free to join us at this earlier service!

We can't wait to celebrate the triumphant resurrection of our Savior with you on Easter morning, March 31. Experience the joy of the empty tomb at one of three services: 7:45am, 9:00am, and 10:30am. All three services will feature the same Blended style, incorporating not only vocalists and organ, but also a brass quintet and a string quartet! Join us for the added treat of hearing the Festival Choir and the Family of Christ Ringers as they lift a joyful noise for the risen King at both the 9:00am and 10:30am services.
