Most children enrolled in Family of Christ Child Care will have their pictures taken on Tuesday, October 7.


• If your child attends on a different day, we kindly ask that you bring them in on Tuesday for their photo before dropping them off in their classroom.


If you have a prayer request, we would love to pray for you!
