On Wednesday, November 18 and Thursday, November 19 fall assessments will be placed in each preschooler's mailbox. These assessments reflect your child's development in the preschool classroom. As teachers we look at the whole child's development. A mark of "Usually" correlates to a skill displayed 80% of the time. As teachers at Family of Christ Christian Preschool our primary goal is to guide your child to a relationship with Christ and secondary for each student to love learning! Preschoolers will begin taking turns bringing home the green family bag. In the family bag is the class "Apple of my Eye" book. We have read the book together as a class however, I encourage each family to read the book with your child as well. The "Harvesting Good Nutrition" unit will begin with a Nutritional Resource presentation. We will illustrate healthy food choices using the colors of a traffic light. Preschoolers will be able to label foods as green, yellow and red light. Red light foods should be eaten less often, yellow light foods should be eaten occasionally and green light foods can be eaten most often.

During Jesus Time the Ten Commandments will be introduced. Students will come to know the timeless Commandments are given to us in love.
