## **Vapor Locked**

A few weeks ago, Shawn was working on removing a pesky bush that infiltrated itself on both sides of the community garden fence. The sun was beating down and it felt like one million degrees outside. He had several outside jobs planned at the church that day, and this one was saved for last. Unfortunately, that meant the sun was directly above in all its glory, and he was feeling it.

I walked over to see how things were going. He was armed with a chainsaw, hedge trimmers and a weed eater and had put a good-sized hurting on the bush. In the trailer attached to the back of his truck, he had all these limbs and leaves of the bush piled there, lots of them with pretty pink and purple berries.

While Shawn and I chatted, he put his tools aside for a minute and gathered up more severed limbs with a rake.

When we finished, he tried to start the chainsaw back up. Nothing.

He tried the weed eater. Nothing.

Hedge trimmers? Nothing.

He was baffled at what was going on and then wondered out loud if they could be vapor locked. He had to explain it to me, and I might not get it all right, but when the fuel in the weed eater (or hedge trimmers or chainsaw) gets too hot, it turns from a liquid to a gas, creating a an air bubble. That air bubble blocks all the needed fuel from making its way to the engine, keeping the weed eater from doing its job.

It's not broken, but it's not functioning right now.

Guys, right now I kind of feel like that weed eater. I'm vapor locked.

Things have been especially stressful and unsettled in my world lately – health stuff, work stuff, and upheaval in the lives of people I care about. That's been my heat.

Much like the weed eater, I'm out of commission. I haven't spent time with God the way I know I need to. I'm existing but not thriving. I'm showing up to work, but not much is getting accomplished. I am not taking care of myself like I need to. I am thinking of people I care about and feel overwhelmed at what they are going through.

The weed eater needs to be in a cool, shady place to avoid becoming vapor locked. I need to prioritize time with God in focused prayer and Scripture. That is the one thing that can switch me from existing to thriving. Every aspect of my day, more specifically my perspective, changes completely when I make this a priority.

There are so many passages on the importances of prayer. Romans 12:12 tells us, "Rejoice in hope, be patient in tribulation, be constant in prayer." Hebrews 12:16 says, "Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need." All true. The same goes for the importance of Scripture. Psalm 119:105 says, "Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path." "I have stored up your word in my heart, that I might not sin against you," from Psalm 119:11.

Knowing all these things, it's so clear what needs to happen. If you are out of sorts like me, maybe give yourself intentional time in the shade with prayer and your Bible. If anyone needs me, that's where I'll be.



#### CONNECTING:

Gathering Room: Phase One renovations are finishing up. Our goal is to have it completed by October. This will be a wonderful place for ministry and class parties, Thrive Group get-togethers, Bible studies, and a location for further prayer on Sunday morning.
