



FAQ for the After-School Care Program **(Kindergarten through 6th grade)**

What does a typical day look like?

The daily schedule is individualized to meet the needs of the children in their classroom. A typical schedule may be:

- 3:30-3:45 p.m.Children arrive at Asbury
- 3:45-4:15 p.m.Snack, Homework, Free Play
- 4:15-4:45 p.m.Activity/Project
- 4:45-6 p.m.Outside/Free Play

What is the teacher to child ratio?

Asbury Children's Center is happy to provide small class sizes that foster strong relationships. We maintain state teacher to child ratios at all times. Many times during the day, we maintain ratios that are lower than state requirements. The kindergarten classroom is licensed for up to 9 children. The first and second grade classroom and the third through sixth grade classroom may have up to 11 children. Each class has one teacher.

What types of activities are there?

A variety of activities are offered, including: art, games, fitness, cooking, science, and activities around themes and holidays/special events.

What schools does the Asbury van pick up from?

Corinth, Briarwood, Santa Fe Trail and Tomahawk. Prairie Elementary drops off children at Asbury.

What is the summer program like?

We provide field-trips 3-5 days per week of the summer program. We visit Prairie Village pool twice each week and go to a park once each week. Special field trips such as T-Bones baseball, Worlds of Fun, Wonderscope, etc. are scheduled on the other two week days.

What do the children do on short breaks from school, such as winter and spring break?

We are open for spring and winter break. Care is provided from 7a.m. to 6 p.m. Field trips are often scheduled during these breaks from school.

How are field trips paid for?

Field trips are paid for by the ACC Through your monthly tuition. No additional charge will occur except for the purchase of your child's pool pass to the Prairie Village Pool.

Is care provided on days when school is closed for conferences and teacher work days?

Yes, we are available from 7a.m. to 6 p.m. on those days. Breakfast, lunch, and afternoon snack are also provided.
