2. How was Pharaoh's refusal ultimately a spiritual problem not a political one?
3. How does knowing who God is have daily and physical ramifications on how we live our lives?
4. Have you ever done the right thing only to see matters get worse? What was that like? How did you respond?
5. What is false with the cliché "the safest place is in the center of God's will"?
6. How does compromise and giving into what is wrong seem to help for a little bit? What is the ultimate outcome?
7. How do you tend to deal with your emotions? Do you tend to suppress your emotions? Do you tend to elevate your emotions? How should we address your emotions Biblically?
8. How does knowing who God is give us courage when matters go from bad to worse?
9. How is our salvation the work of God?
10. Do you agree with this statement: Salvation begins with God because it starts with the grace of God and ends with the glory of God.
11. Why is the inheritance of God's people better in the New Covenant (union with Christ) than in the Abrahamic covenant (land of Canaan)?
