Philippians 1:9-26
Small Group Discussion Starters

Use the following questions as ‘starters’ for your small group. Think of these questions like appetizers to get the conversation going. You are free to explore further questions or ideas that you may have from today’s message on Philippians 1:19-26.

1. What is the gospel? Try to describe the gospel in one word, with one sentence, or in one paragraph. If you can, use specific scriptures to back up your description.
2. The main point of Pastor Garrett’s message from Philippians 1:19-26 is “when the noise of the gospel is elevated it impacts how we experience the present moment and what we pursue in the present moment.”
 - a. How does the gospel impact our experience of the present moment?
 - b. How does the gospel impact what we pursue in the present moment?
3. For further reflection and discussion read II Corinthians 5:1-10.
4. A litmus test to test what might be your true treasure is to fill in this sentence: *If I were to die tonight and be united with Jesus, would I be sad because out on _____.* To the best of your ability try to answer this question with brutal honesty.
5. The world encourages us to “dream big dreams.” Is there anything wrong with dreaming big? How can we guard ourselves from disappointment and discouragement if our dreams never come true?
6. What can you do this week to invest in the spiritual growth of another person?
