Dress Code For Girls:

- Navy Pleated pants, shorts, or skirts
- White, Red or Navy Polo Shirt with school logo. May be short sleeve or long sleeve.
- White or Navy Turtleneck with school logo.
- Burgundy V- Neck Cardigan Sweater with Embroidered School Monogram (Monogram is optional)
- Navy Sweatshirt with Embroidered School Monogram
- Navy Jacket with Embroidered School Monogram
- No open toe, no backless, and no boots or dress shoes with more than 1-inch heel.
- Tennis Shoes are acceptable as long as they do not have violent characters.

CHAPEL DRESS CODE: (Wednesdays)

- Plaid Skirt (*3rd—8th Grade*)

Dress Code For Boys:

- Navy Pleated pants or shorts.

- Navy Sweatshirt with Embroidered School Monogram

MBCS Dress Code Policy

Dress Code Standards:

- ALL shirts, blouses and turtlenecks must be tucked in at all times.
- HAIRSTYLES which communicate a desire to appear rebellious or unconventional will be considered inappropriate. Hair should be a natural color and not two-toned. It must be neat and the length in front should not affect the student's vision nor prevent the teacher from having eye contact. Boys' hair must not extend below the top of the collar. Hair tails, Mohawks, and any other unconventional hair styles are prohibited. Parents should contact the school if they have a question regarding a particular hair style
- HATS are not allowed at school (except for designated Hat Days)
- MAKE-UP is discouraged, however if it is worn, it must be modest and not draw attention to the person. Clear Nail Polish is acceptable.
- JEWELRY or accessories that are not a positive reflection of MBCS or represent gangs, cults or satanic symbolism (or occult or superstitious) are prohibited. Symbols of non-Christian religions are prohibited. Small earrings are permitted for girls however no dangling or multiple earrings are permitted. Post or studs may be worn up to three piercings. (the definition of an "earring" will be decided by the principal, not by the students or their parents.)
- BELTS are required for boys and girls at all times when their pants or shorts have belt loops. (At the teacher's discretion, an exception may be made for Kindergarteners or first-graders.)
- SIZING/ALTERATIONS/REPAIR. Any clothing that is improperly sized (too tight, too big) will not be permitted. The hem of a girl's skirt (or skorts) may not be above her knees. Alterations may not be made to the manufacturer's clothes other than for the benefit of appropriate sizing. Clothes must be in good condition. Holes or tears are not permitted and must be properly repaired. Please replace damaged clothing as soon as possible.
