



MBCS Playground Rules

The playground is a safe place for the students to release their energy, stretch their legs, and relax their minds. This is their opportunity to be away from the classroom's rigid structure. In order for us to keep the playground safe for everyone the following guidelines have been created:

1. Use good sportsmanship. Take turns, follow game rules, and don't cheat.
2. Be polite & courteous to your classmates and MBCS staff.
3. We have a "hands off" policy which includes hitting, kicking, grabbing, pushing, etc.
4. No fighting or games that entail pretend fighting. (Ex: ninjas, kick boxing, shooting, etc.)
5. Wood chips are not to be played with.
6. If you are hurt in any way, please report to a staff member so that they may take the necessary steps to assist you. Please do not play scream, pretend cry, or whine. We may think you are seriously injured and need help.
7. For your safety and the safety of your peers, use the playground equipment properly. Do not climb walls or benches, and do not attempt to walk up the slides.
