Quarter 1: August 12 - October 9			
Aug 12	Matthew 7:24-25	"Anyone who listens to my teaching and follows it is wise, like a person who builds a house on a solid rock. 25: Though the rain comes in torrents and the floodwaters rise and the wind beat against that house, it won't collapse because it is built on bedrock.	Back to School
August 19	Matthew 7:26-27	But anyone who hears my teaching and doesn't obey it is foolish, like a person who builds a house on sand. 27: When the rains and floods come and the winds beat against that house, it will collapse with a mighty crash."	
Aug 26	Matthew 5:1-2	One day, as he saw the crowds gathering, Jesus went up on the mountainside and sat down. His disciples gathered around him, 2: and he began to teach them.	
Sep 2	Matthew 5:3	"God blesses those who are poor and realize their need for him, for the Kingdom of Heaven is theirs.	
Sep 9	Matthew 5:4	God blesses those who mourn, for they will be comforted.	
Sept 16	Matthew 5:5	God blesses those who are humble, for they will inherit the whole earth.	
Sept 23	Matthew 5:6	God blesses those who hunger and thirst for justice, for they will be satisfied.	
September 30	Matthew 5:7	God blesses those who are merciful, for they will be shown mercy.	
Quarter 2: October 12 - December 18			
October 7	Matthew 5:8	God blesses those whose hearts are pure, for they will see God.	
October 14	Matthew 5:9	God blesses those who work for peace, for they will be called the children of God.	
October 21	Matthew 5:11-12	God blesses you when people mock you and persecute you and lie about you and say all sorts of evil things against you because you are my followers. 12: Be happy about it! Be very glad! For a great reward awaits you in heaven. And remember, the ancient prophets were persecuted in the same way.	
October 28	Matthew 5:10	God blesses those who are persecuted for doing right, for the kingdom of Heaven is theirs.	
November 4	Matthew 5:13	"You are the salt of the earth. But what good is salt if it has lost its flavor? Can you make it salty again? It will be thrown out and trampled underfoot as worthless."	
November 11	No School	Veterans Day	
November 18	Matthew 5:14-16	You are the light of the world- like a city on a hilltop that cannot be hidden. 15: No one lights a lamp and then puts it under a basket. Instead, a lamp is placed on a stand, where it gives light to everyone in the house. 16: In the same way, let your good deeds shine out for all to see, so that everyone will praise your heavenly Father.	
November 25	No School	Thanksgiving Break	
December 2	Matthew 6:1-2	"Watch out! Don't do your good deeds publicly, to be admired by others, for you will lose the reward from your Father in heaven. 2: When you give to someone in need, don't do as the hypocrites do- blowing trumpets in the synagogues and streets to call attention to their acts of charity! I tell you the truth, they have received all the reward they will ever get.	
December 9	Matthew 6:3-4	But when you give to someone in need, don't let your left hand know what your right hand is doing. 4: Give your gifts in private, and your Father, who sees everything, will reward you.	
December 16	Matthew 6:5	"When you pray, don't be like the hypocrites who love to pray publicly on street corners and in the synagogues where everyone can see them. I tell you the truth, that is all the reward they will ever get.	Christmas Chapel
December 21-31	No School	Christmas Break	
January 6	Matthew 6:7-8	"When you pray, don't babble on and on as the Gentiles do. They think their prayers are answered merely by repeating their words again and again. 8: Don't be like them, for your Father knows exactly what you need even before you ask him!	New Years Chapel
Quarter 3: December 21- March 12			
January 13	Matthew 6:9-10	Pray like this: Our Father in heaven, may your name be kept holy. 10: May your Kingdom come soon. May your will be done on earth, as it is in heaven.	

January 20	Matthew 6:11-13	Give us today the food we need, and forgive us our sins, as we have forgiven those who sin against us. And don't let us yield to temptation, but rescue us from the evil one.	
January 27	Matthew 6:14-15	If you forgive those who sin against you, your heavenly Father will forgive you. 15: But if you refuse to forgive others, your Father will not forgive your sins.	
February 3	Matthew 6:16-18	"And when you fast, don't make it obvious, as the hypocrites do, for they try to look miserable and disheveled so people will admire them for their fasting. I tell you the truth, that is the only reward they will ever get. 17: But when you fast, comb your hair and wash your face. 18: Then no one will notice that you are fasting, except your Father, who knows what you do in private. And your Father, who sees everything, will reward you.	
February 10	Matthew 6:19-21	"Don't store up treasures here on earth, where moths eat them and rust destroys them, and where thieves break in and steal. 20: Store your treasures in heaven, where moths and rust cannot destroy, and thieves do not break in and steal. 21: Wherever your treasure is, there the desires of your heart will also be.	
February 17	Matthew 6:24	"No one can serve two masters. For you will hate one and love the other; you will be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and be enslaved to money.	
February 24	Matthew 6:25	"That is why I tell you not to worry about everyday life- whether you have enough food and drink, or enough clothes to wear. Isn't life more than food, and your body more than clothing?	
March 3	Matthew 6:28-30	"Any why worry about your clothing? Look at the lilies of the field and how they grow. They don't work or make their clothing, yet Solomon in all his glory was not dressed as beautifully as they are. And if God cares so wonderfully for wildflowers that are here today and thrown into the fire tomorrow, he will certainly care for you. Why do you have so little faith?	
March 10	Matthew 6:31-32	"So don't worry about these things, saying, 'What will we eat? What will we drink? What will we wear?' 32: These things dominate the thoughts of unbelievers, but your heavenly Father already knows all your needs.

March 17	Matthew 6:34	"So don't worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will bring its own worries. Today's trouble is enough for today.

May 12	Matthew 7:13-14	"You can enter God's Kingdom only through the narrow gate. The highway to hell is broad, and its gate is wide for the many who choose that way.	
May 19	Matthew 7: 14	14: But the gateway to life is very narrow and the road is difficult, and only a few ever find it.
