FROM THE FINANCE OFFICE

RCRC's donations to the operating fund for May were lower than expenses, so that our expenses are about \$10K more than receipts so far in 2026.

Please continue your generosity over the next few months so that we do not fall too far behind over the summer.

Operating Account: May 2026
Budget: \$39,210.47
Receipts: \$25,893.60
Expenses: \$36,319.12

Year to date, through May 2026:
Budget: \$196,052.35
Receipts: \$134,511.71
Expenses: \$144,017.89
