He holds a Doctor of Ministry in Church Growth from Fuller Seminary, a Master of Theology in Preaching and Worship from Princeton Seminary, a Master of Divinity from Calvin Theological Seminary, and a Bachelor of Arts from Wheaton College.

Throughout his ministry, Dr. Loerop has faithfully led congregations across North America, including long-term pastorates in New Jersey, Michigan, Ontario, and Iowa, as well as numerous interim roles in Wisconsin, California, Minnesota, and Colorado. His leadership has been marked by a deep commitment to church health, coaching congregations and leaders
