#### **RCRC Financial Status**

As is typical during a pastoral vacancy, both expenses and donations for RCRC's general operations are less than in typical years, but, as of the end of September, donations are slightly above expenses. However, the last quarter of the year has some large one-time expenses, so we anticipate about \$100K of remaining expenses. This is less than 1/4 of our original budget, but more than our average quarterly donations so far this year.
