# Through the Bible in One Year

The elders invite the Rochester CRC community to join us in an adventure - reading through the entire Bible together - starting on Jan 1, 2026.

We will be using the M'Cheyne calendar which reads through the Old Testament once, the New Testament twice, and the Psalms twice.

Each day there are readings from 4 books, usually one in the Pentateuch and history books, one in the prophets, and two in the New Testament and/or Psalms.

This generally involves about 20-30 minutes of reading each day.

For those unable to maintain that pace, there is an option to cut back to two readings a day and complete it in two years. Here's a printable 2-year schedule:
