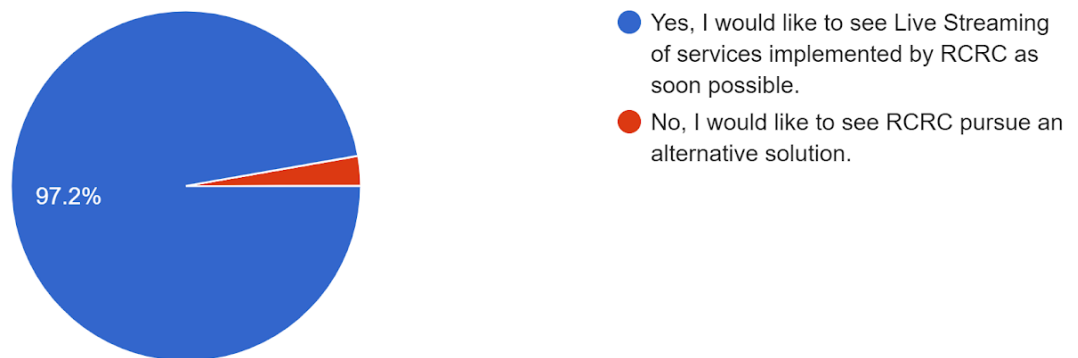

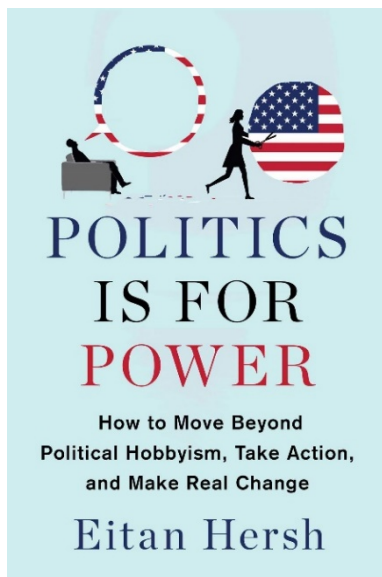
School Supplies for School #33
