Directions to 160 Genteel Lane from Wilmington

- 1. Take Isabel Holmes Bridge
- 2. Turn right onto US-17 N/US-421 N
- 3. Continue to follow US-421 N for 21 miles
 - 4. Turn left onto NC-11 S/NC-53 W

(there will be blinking yellow traffic lights and a Sunoco gas station)

- 5. Go a little over 2 miles and turn right onto Genteel Lane (look for a Day in the Country sign)
 - 6. Continue down Genteel Lane to the end, where you will see white house and parking signs.



Lone Ranger Guests are welcome to join A Day In The Country by registering in advance or coming out on the day of event at \$200/Lone Ranger Ticket.

What you need to know:

- BRING YOUR OWN SHOTGUN AND SHELLS (shells should be size #8 or #9)
- SKEET SHOOTING: spots will be available to shoot on a first come, first serve basis. For sponsors and guests only. Presenting and Bullseye Sponors have priority skeet shooting between 8:30-10:00am.
- Bring safety goggles and earplugs if you prefer.
- No alcohol can be consumed prior to skeet shooting NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Please keep guns unloaded at all times until you are at the skeet station. Waiver required for skeet shooting.
- Cane fishing poles, bait, and equipment will be provided for fishing but you are encouraged to bring your own.
- Winner in each sport will be presented with a prize and announced during awards.
- This is an adult event only event insurance requires attendees to be 21 years or older.
- A shuttle from Genteel to the FBC Activity Center will be available at the end of the event.
