

FPC SESSION NOTES - STATED MEETING - MONDAY – MARCH 23, 2026

Wedding Approved: Olivia Wyatt to Alex Cochran on October 17, 2026 (non-member)

Finance and Endowments: John Summerford reported a positive finance report. Total receipts through February are above budget by \$21K and ahead of same time last year by \$67.5K. Expenses are under budget yielding a net positive of \$41K after two months. Pledges were up and last year's pledges were still coming in. (See Financial Chart)

Personnel: Tony Hubbard reported that an offer had been made and accepted to fill the vacant Communications position for the front office. He also reported that much work, and discernment had been dedicated by the Personnel Committee over the request to have a dedicated staff person for our children and family faith formation. He reported that we have 139 children in our church from birth – 5th grade, representing 78 families. Personnel has approved the need and finance has approved the funding for what would be at first a part-time position. A job description is being created and will come back to Session for final approval.

Long Range Planning: Robert McLeod presented the updated Manual of Operations for Session's approval which included updates to the Sexual Misconduct and the Child and Youth Protection Policies. Session approved.

Properties: Forest Wilson presented the proposal from Architecture Works to assist First Presbyterian to develop a scope of work for repairs and restoration to the Sanctuary and areas of the Chapel to include evaluation of sanctuary ceiling tiles, sanctuary flooring, improve accessibility in both worship areas, evaluate sound and AV systems, and preserve and restore the existing stained glass windows in both worship areas. They will also provide an evaluation of moisture issues past and present. This proposal has been signed off by Finance, Long Range Planning and Properties Committees. The cost of the evaluation is estimated to be \$62K. This will be funded by the 1820 Fund. Session approved. Two rubber speed control devices have been installed on the pre-school driveway.
